METHOD OF PAYMENT

Payment for goods, professional services, and cash advancements is expected at time of arrangements and required prior to the services rendered. For your convenience, we accept cash, check, credit card (Visa, Master Card, American Express, or Discover) or an approved irrevocable insurance assignment.

Whether your choice is casketed interment or cremation, selecting a permanent resting place is an important aspect of your final arrangements, and provides a lasting legacy to leave your family and loved ones. Selecting the cemetery property that is right for you is made simple at Joshua Tree Memorial Park.

As the Morongo Basin's premier cemetery, Joshua Tree Memorial Park has memorial properties to suit a variety of personal needs and preferences, including a dedicated veteran's area, natural burial sites, dedicated scattering gardens, and properties with panoramic desert views.

Property options for burial (requiring a casket) include:

- Earth burial in a standard lawn crypt
- Earth burial in a lawn space that allows upright gravestones
- Above-earth interment in a standing crypt or mausoleum*

Property options for burial (not requiring a casket) include:

- Natural Earth burial in a dedicated "green" area as sanctioned by the Green Burial Council

Property options for cremation include:

- Earth burial in a standard urn lawn
- Above-earth inurnment in a garden niche wall
- Dedicated scattering areas for sanctioned scattering
- Desert scape ossuary

Cemetery Requirement Explanations and Information:

Interment Schedule(Burials)

Can be scheduled **Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays**. Off days, weekends, and holidays are subject to administrative approval as well as additional overtime fees. This includes the burial of human remains and cremated remains (to include scattering).

Companion Privilege Fee

Payment of this fee entitles the purchaser to the right to inter a second person in a single grave. Cemetery opening and closing fees and cemetery outer burial container requirements will apply to each interment.

Endowment Care Fee

This is a required fee to ensure general care and maintenance of the property for future times.

Opening and Closing Fee (Burial, Committal, Interment, Title & Recording)

Includes the following items, dependent upon ground or mausoleum interment: Administrative or clerical charges, including accounting, title search and recording, legal requirements, verifying right of interment, checking and recording interment order, scheduling services, preparing instructions for workers, etc.; preparation of interment space with labor, trucks and other equipment for removing sod, digging interment space, removing excess dirt; the use of lowering devices, chairs, artificial grass, tarpaulins, brace boards, matting; removing marble crypt or niche front, placing seal slab and refitting marble front, etc.

Note: Engraving done prior to death will require additional Final Date fees. Scattering Granite Engraving and Cenotaph is limited to 3 lines, and must conform to Cemetery guidelines. Inscription, Feature, Cenotaph, and Granite Engraving includes Name and Dates up to 40 characters. Additional characters will be charged at \$3.00 each. Art work and Emblems require quote. Scattering packages include optional Granite Engraving or Cenotaphs.

Columbarium Urn Requirements:

Desert Quail – Spartan Basic urn only.

Park View - Any standard size urn.

Floral Regulations*

Flower vases approved by the cemetery office are required. Only real flowers are permitted in approved flower vases. Balloons, etc. are not permitted. Planting of trees, flora or herbage is not permitted around the grave. Holiday decorations are permitted the week prior and following each holiday subject to approval by Cemetery Office.

Mausoleum and Niches*

Nothing may be taped or affixed to the mausoleum or cremation niche fronts.

Loitering*

Persons other than plot owners, relatives or friends, shall be permitted to loiter in the Cemetery.

Pets*

Pets shall not be allowed on cemetery grounds unless on a leash.

Endowment Care*

The Endowment Care Fund is a trust fund composed of deposits by the purchasers of memorial property. It is not part of the purchase price. Such deposits are accumulated together to form an Endowment Care Fund in order that the income from the fund may provide for the general care and maintenance of the property when future revenue is no longer available to assist in upkeep.

Memorials*

A memorial marker can be purchased through an outside vender. It is not required to purchase markers through Joshua Tree Memorial Park. All memorials are subject to the acceptance or rejection by the Cemetery prior to their placement. Acceptance or rejection shall be based on the specifications of the materials, size, color, design and inscription requirements or standard of each plot location.

* These abbreviated Rules and Regulations are intended to serve as a brief guideline. The complete set of Rules and Regulations for Joshua Tree Memorial Park are available in the Cemetery office.

* Joshua Tree Memorial Park is **not** responsible for stolen or lost vases or any other items placed on plots.

* All merchandise sold at Joshua Tree Memorial Park is subject to California sales tax, and certain purchases are subject to California Department of Consumer Affairs fee required by State law.

Natural rocks, wildflowers, shrubs and groundcover serve as markers. For Families Selecting Natural Burial: Joshua Tree Memorial Park makes available several natural "green" burial options and is one of a select group of funeral providers certified by the Green Burial Council, a nonprofit organization that encourages the use of burial as a means of facilitating the restoration, acquisition, and stewardship of natural areas throughout the United States. For such arrangements, formaldehyde-based embalming is prohibited as is the use of metal or concrete grave liners,



burial vaults, or other permanent burial containers. Caskets, coffins or alternative containers used to enclose and transport the dead are made of biodegradable materials and are available in a range of prices. Home wakes, public visitations, church funerals and graveside services are options that may be arranged within the limited time frame green burial allows (please check with your mortuary provider). We comply with the code that no formaldehyde-based embalming will occur and the use of only biodegradable caskets and biodegradable urns will be made available for use in green cemeteries. Our professionals can discuss your options with you based upon service preferences and confer with your mortuary of choice. Natural Burial options allow families to select a natural “green” burial. Many families will have a gathering formal or informal prior to or after the “green” committal. This allows a time of remembrance for family and friends to come together prior to the green committal.
